In conjunction with SLO™, I will be working closely with our discipline department in the areas of Peer Mediation and Anti-Bullying. With the help of teachers and the students themselves, we will be identifying situations in which students are having chronic social difficulty, for example, when one child is being left out or when two or more students are constantly arguing.

Our goal is to talk to these students early to help them resolve the situation before it escalates. I will also be working with the outreach department to organize community service projects and encourage school-wide participation.
